Applicants under EWS Category are required to submit a valid income certificate of Parents/guardians (as per annexure V) from the employer as on financial year ending March, 2024 (Issued on or after 1st April, 2025).

It is to be noted that candidates who do not provide the required documents in support of their claim of Other Backward Classes (Non-Creamy Layer) / EWS will be treated as General.
