There shall be two initial Directors of the Company, Dr. Uday Shankar Dixit, Professor of IIT, Guwahati and noted expert in advanced manufacturing and one senior faculty member of the Institute. The Registered Office of the Company shall be in the campus of the Institute.

	A meeting was held on 30/12/2022 at Department of Heavy Industries, Udyog Bhawan, New Delhi in the presence of representatives of DHI, MoE, HEC and NIAMT. The representative of HEC presented three options as communicated by the earlier for settlement of the lease agreement. However, Smt. Renuka Mishra, Economic Advisor, DHI suggested not to discuss on those options but to figure out some realistic approach to regularize the pending settlement of lease agreement. Director, NIAMT informed that NIAMT has started a payment of Rs. 51,804/- per year as the Lease Rent to HEC as per provision under the erstwhile Bihar Government Rule. It is finalized that further renewal of Lease Agreement will be considered for thirty years from 1998 to 2028.
Resolution	Noted. The Board of Governors appreciated the effort made by the Ministry of Education (MoE) in resolving the issue for the time being, however the Board emphasized the need for a permanent solution like the transfer of land to the Institute.
