The Institute received the Letter of Intent for conferment of Deemed to be University (Distinct Category) status under section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, vide MoE F. No. 9-7/2020-U.3(A), dated 11/10/2023. A special BoG meeting was held on 02/11/2023 to finalize the compliance and reconstitution of the NIAMT Society.

As per advice of the BoG and in compliance to the follow-up email of the MoE dated 23/11/2023, the compliance was submitted to the Technical Section of MoE, vide letter No. RGO-34/2020-21/1487, dated 24/11/2023, and a copy was later submitted to the UGC Section of MoE, vide letter No. RGO-34/2020-21/1497, dated 08/12/2023.

MoE, vide F. No. 9-7/2020-U.3(A), dated 26/12/2023, has forwarded the compliance submitted by the Institute to University Grant Commission for examination.



	Student Fostering Unit (Gymkhana) organizes the Annual Mega Event titled "JINKS Pranav" each year during February/March. Total budget of the event remains around 15.00 lakh, out of which Institute was supporting about 10.00 lakh from OH-31 grant and balance amount were collected by the students through sponsorships.  To reduce support from OH-31 grant, the Gymkhana Fee has been increased starting from the 2023-24 Admission Batch. Total Gymkhana Fee expected to be collected for the year 2023-24 is Rs. 26,84,700/-. Based on the fee collection, Gymkhana Committee has prepared a budget of Rs. 14,03,000/- for "JINKS Pranav 2024" to be spent out of the Gymkhana Fee. Proposal of the Chairman (SFU/Gymkhana) is given as <b>Annexure – V</b> . It is proposed that Rs. 14.00 lakh may be approved for expenditure from Gymkhana Fee IRG and balance expenditure may be met out of the sponsorships to be arranged by the students for this purpose.
